AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND FEES FOR PHYSICAL EXAMINATION, HEALTH CERTIFICATE, SANITARY AND SAFETY INSPECTION PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING THE

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of General Frias, Cavite, that

SERVICE FEE FOR HEALTH EXAMINATION:

Section 1. - IMPOSITION OF FEE - A fee of Twenty Pesos (P20.00) shall be paid by an individual who undergoes a mphysical examination by the Municipal Health Officer as required under existing ordinances and laws.

In addition, a fee of Thirty Pesos (P30.00) shall be paid by food handlers and other required by existing ordinances and laws to undergo urine, stool and sputum examinations. When ever warranted the Municipal Health Officer can request for additional laboratory examinations or may request a different kind of laboratory examinations. The result of the physical and other laboratory examinations shall be contained in a medical certificate to be issued the Municipal Health Officer.

A fee of Ten Pesos (P10.00) shall be collected for an

Section 2. - TIME OF PAYMENT - The fee shall be paid the Treasurer before physical

Section 3. - PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLIANCE - Individuals providing the aforementioned services without the necessary whealth certificate shall be penalized accordingly.

Section 3. - PENALTY FOR NON-COMPOSED PROVIDED TO BE A SECTION A. - B1 - HEALTH CENTERS AND THE SECTION A. - B1 - HEALTH CENTERS AND THE SECTION Section 4. - B1 - HEALTH CERTIFICATE FEE - Every person required by the existing laws and regulations to secure health certificates from the Municipal Medical and Dental Office shall pay a fee of Thirty Pesos (P30.00).

Section 4. - B2 - TIME OF PAYMENT - The sanitary and safety permit and health certificate fees herein prescribed shall be paid at the Office of the Municipal Treasurer before any business or occupations be lawfully begun or pursued and upon renewal of the same every year thereafter within the first ninety (90) days of the year.

section 4. - B3 - ANNUAL INSPECTION OF PREMISES -Except and otherwise provided, the Municipal Health Officer or his duly authorized representative shall conduct an annual inspection of all houses, accessorias, building for rent or as soon as circumstances require and all business establishments (commercial, industrial, agricultural) in their respective localities in order to determine the adequacy of ventilation, propriety of habitation, general sanitary conditions, and general safety conditions pursuant to existing laws, rules and regulations. Sanitary and safety permit shall be issued to the owner by the Municipal

Health Officer or his duly authorized representative after such inspection was conducted and was found to be safe and sanitary.

B. SANITARY AND SAFETY INSPECTION FEES

Every owner or operator of business, industrial, commercial, or agricultural establishments, accesoria, building or house for rent, shall secure sanitary and safety certificates of permit for the purpose of supervision and enforcement of the existing rules and regulations on sanitary and safety of the public upon payment to the Municipal Treasurer of an annual fee in accordance with the following schedule:

In case an individual or partnership or a corporation conducts or operates two or more businesses in one place or establishment, the sanitary inspection permit with the highest rate shall be imposed ..

PENALTY (EMPLOYEES)

- 1. FIRST OFFENSE Warning shall be issued specifying that a similar offense will merit a more severe penalty. The identified employee will be required to undergo the ecessary examinations within 24 hrs. after noting eficiency.
- SECOND OFFENSE A fine of P50.00 will be imposed. 2. employee will be required to undergo necessary examinations within 24 hrs. after noting the deficiency.
 - THIRD OFFENSE A fine of P100.00 will be imposed. The employee will be required to attend 2-day seminar to be held at the main health center. The employee will be required to undergo the necessary examinations within the duration of the training period.

Owners, managers and operators of establishments who will employ workers without the necessary health certificate shall be penalized accordingly:

- 1. FIRST OFFENSE Warning will be issued specifying that a similar offense will merit more severe penalties. The employer will assume the cost of
- 2. SECOND OFFENSE A fine of P100.00 will be imposed ber employee working without the required health certificate. The employer will assume the cost aboratory examinations, and the barriers.
 - THIRD OFFENSE A fine of P200.00 per employee 3. found working without the required health certificate shall be imposed accordingly. The owners, managers, and operators of establishments will be required to attend a two-day seminar to be held at the main health center.
 - FOURTH OFFENSE A fine of P300.00 per employee found working without the required health certificate. In addition, the employee concerned will be prevented from conducting his/her duties pending issuance of the health The suspension will only be lifted once certificate. employees concerned has secured the required certificates.
