DECLARING THE LAST WEEK OF OCTOBER AS COOPERATIVE WEEK IN THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS, RECOGNIZING THE OUTSTANDING COOPERATIVES IN THE CITY AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, a cooperative is an autonomous association of persons with common bond of interest and united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social, and personal needs and aspirations through a jointly owned and democratically controlled economic activity or business;

WHEREAS, common to all cooperatives are the values of self-help, self-responsibility, democracy, equality, equity and solidarity;

WHEREAS, the different cooperatives in the City of General Trias who have been active partners of the local government unit in terms of community development have successfully provided business and other services to their members;

WHEREAS, the different cooperatives characterized by the principles of the common cooperative values as mentioned above and duly recognized by the General Trias City Cooperative Development Council and accredited by the Sangguniang Panlungsod have effectively stressed the spirit of cooperativism;

WHEREAS, in recognition and to further increase awareness on the importance of the cooperatives in the local government unit in terms of economic, social and cultural development, a special week of celebration is necessary;

WHEREAS, the objective is to motivate cooperatives in strengthening their entire operations, applying the values and principles of cooperative, thereby searching a model cooperative in accordance to its level/category;

WHEREAS, a Technical Working Group (TWG) shall be organized with representatives from the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), the Cooperative Division of the Provincial Cooperative, Livelihood, and Entrepreneurial Development Office (PCLEDO), the Cooperative Development Unit of the Local Government Unit of General Trias, and other parties that may be determined by the TWG who shall select outstanding cooperatives in General Trias;

WHEREAS, activities relevant to the celebration of the Cooperative Day in the City of General Trias shall be supported by funds;

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WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Jonas Glyn P. Labuguen and duly seconded by all Members present,

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as "COOPERATIVE WEEK AND OUTSTANDING COOPERATIVES ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY – It is the policy of the City Government of Gen. Trias to recognize the important role the cooperatives have in the community.

SECTION 3. CELEBRATION - The last week of October is hereby declared as the **City of General Trias Cooperative Week**.

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION – The City of General Trias through the Office of the City Mayor in coordination with the City Cooperative Development Unit shall promote and implement the city-wide celebration of the Cooperative Week annually.

SECTION 5. RECOGNITION OF MOST OUTSTANDING COOPERATIVES - The selection of the outstanding cooperative will cover the following categories:

A. Categories:

- Most Outstanding Primary Cooperative:
 - o Micro Scale (less than Php 3 000 000.00) Assets
 - o Small Scale (PhP3,000,000.00 to Php 15 000 000.00) Assets
 - o Medium Scale (Php 15 000 000.00 to Php 100 000 000.00) Assets
 - o Large Scale (more than Php 100 000 000.00) Assets
- B. Cooperatives which excel in a specific field will be given special citations based on the following guidelines:
 - o Exemplary Environmental Protection and Conservation Program
 - o Outstanding Community Involvement and Development Program
 - o Excellence in Membership Growth and Expansion Program
 - Excellence in Providing Financial Products and Services to Members

SECTION 6. GUIDELINES, CRITERIA AND EVALUATION OF THE SELECTION OF THE OUTSTANDING COOPERATIVE AWARDEES:


A. GUIDELINES AND CRITERA:

- 1. With complete reportorial requirements submitted on time (for the preceding year, submitted on or before April 30, 2017) (MOV: stamp received by the Regional Office);
- 2. With at least Satisfactory Ratings in both Social and Performance Audit Reports for all categories;

Compliant with the legal and administrative requirements of Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), local government unit and other government agencies;

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- 3. Elected/appointed officials of the cooperatives must have no business in conflict with the business of their corresponding cooperative;
- 4. Must have an office in the designated address as indicated in the articles of cooperation;
- 5. Must have been issued Certificate of Compliance or Certificate of Good Standing for the three (3) preceding years;
- 6. Must be operationally gainful:
 - o for Medium/Large Cooperative three (3) consecutive years, and

- o for Micro and Small cooperative two (2) consecutive years;
- 7. Must be affiliated with a federation or union;
- 8. With Sangguniang Panlungsod Accreditation.

SECTION 7. FUNDING - The funding for the implementation of this Ordinance shall come from the yearly appropriation of the Office of the Mayor - Cooperative Development Unit.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and posting in any conspicuous places in the City.
