PRESCRIBING A TWO (2)-YEAR MORATORIUM ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GASOLINE STATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS.

WHEREAS, the proliferation of gasoline stations in the City, reaching a total of 35, empirically is found to be enough for its current population density and the neighboring communities;

WHEREAS, the community of gas dealers and investors have been increasingly vocal on the shortfall problems caused by the uncontrolled proliferation of the gasoline stations;

WHEREAS, with due respect to free enterprise and generous concern to gas dealers' and investors' plight, the Sanggunian has come up with a temporary provision to the said matter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of General Trias in Session assembled, that:

Section 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING A TWO (2)-YEAR MORATORIUM ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GASOLINE STATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS".

Section 2. REGULATED ACTS. There is hereby prescribed a two (2)-year moratorium in the establishment of new gasoline stations within the City of General Trias. This Ordinance applies to any new applications establishing gasoline stations in the City of General Trias. In relation with this, no permit shall be issued by the concerned offices in the City pertaining to the establishment of a new gasoline station in the City of General Trias within the moratorium period of two (2) years.

Section 3. EXEMPTIONS. This Ordinance shall exempt those existing gasoline stations as of the date of approval of this Ordinance or those existing but which will merely change dealership or will change business ownership.

Section 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts that are not affected thereof shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days upon approval, posting in conspicuous places in the City or publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
