PROHIBITING DRONE OPERATION WITHIN ONE HUNDRED METRES (100 m) FROM JAIL FACILITIES, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS) or drone by its nature, can be used as a tool for gathering information through recording or taking photographs;

WHEREAS, at present, there is a growing use of drones which the areas of its applications have expanded overtime;

WHEREAS, drones could also be used in transporting illegal drugs, deadly weapons, and other contrabands, as well as in the surveillance of jail facilities and premises, which could compromise the safety and security of the jail facilities;

WHEREAS, under Philippine Civil Aviation Rules 11 and Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) 21-14, no person shall operate small Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) or Remotely Piloted Aircraft (RPA) in a populous area, and pursuant to that rule, jails are considered populous and congested areas;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP), pursuant to the regulations issued by the CAAP, prescribes a Standard Operating Procedure on the detection, prevention, and handling of RPAS or UAV, aimed at maintaining the safety and security of jail facilities in the City;

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will help maintain peace and order, enhance the physical security of the jail facilities and guarantee the safety and security of the City and its constituents;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Isagani L. Culanding duly seconded by SP Member Vivencio Q. Lozares, Jr.,

Continuation...page 2 of City Ordinance No. 22-30 (General):

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "DRONE NO-FLY ZONE WITHIN 100 METRES FROM JAIL FACILITIES ORDINANCE".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE - This Ordinance is ordained to ensure and promote public safety and security by prohibiting the operation of drones within one hundred metres (100 m) from jail facilities within the territorial jurisdiction of the General Trias City Bureau of Jail Management and Penology.

SECTION 3. SCOPE - This Ordinance shall apply to all persons, who shall willfully operate drone within 100 metres radius of jail facilities of General Trias City Jail.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS – As used in this Ordinance the following terms shall be construed to mean as follows:

- a. JAIL FACILITIES places for the confinement of people accused or convicted of a crime; and
- b. UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE (UAV) commonly known as drone, is an aircraft without a human pilot aboard. UAVs are components of an Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) which includes a UAV, a ground-based controller, and a system of communications between the two. The flight of AUVs may operate with various degree of authority, either under remote control by human operator or autonomous by onboard computers.

SECTION 5. EXEMPTIONS - This Ordinance shall not cover law enforcement agencies, emergency management offices and those duly authorized by the LGU with coordination to the Jail Management.

SECTION 6. PENALTIES - Violation of this Ordinance shall be meted the penalty of:

> First Offense **Second Offense**

Php 1 000.00,

Php 1 500.00, and

Third Offense

Php 2 500.00 or imprisonment

for a period of more three (3) months but not

exceeding six (6) months or

both of such fine and

imprisonment at the discretion

of the Court.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS - The City Police, the concerned barangay which has territorial jurisdiction over the jail facilities in the City, as well as the BJMP shall formulate the necessary Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance.

"DRONE NO-FLY ZONE WITHIN 100 METRES FROM JAIL FACILITIES" conspicuously outside of the jail facility.

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATIONS - The City Government shall appropriate funds for the implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, resolutions, circulars, letters of the instruction, memorandums, and rules and regulations inconsistent with the provision of the Ordinance are hereby repealed and modified accordingly

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason of reasons, ant part of the provisions of the Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be full force and effect.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
