DECLARING  $10^{\text{TH}}$  DAY OF DECEMBER AS THE HUMAN RIGHTS DAY AND  $4^{\text{TH}}$  TO  $10^{\text{TH}}$  DAYS OF DECEMBER AS HUMAN RIGHTS AWARENESS WEEK IN THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State values the dignity of every human persons and guarantees full respect for human rights;

WHEREAS, the 10<sup>th</sup> of December marks the anniversary of the signing of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) in 1948 which has served as the basis of the Constitutional Bill of Rights in almost every country around the world, making it one of the most significant documents in the history of humanity;

WHEREAS, as provided in Republic Act No. 9201 also known as National Human Rights Consciousness Week Act of 2002, all government agencies including government-owned and-controlled corporations are enjoined to celebrate the week through simple and appropriate ceremonies and activities to make the people aware of their basic human rights;

WHEREAS, as proclaimed in 10 December 1950, the celebration of Human Rights Day calls upon all citizens, officials, teachers and all concerned individuals and offices to publicize the text of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and to cause it to be disseminated, displayed and expounded as provided in Proclamation No. 225, Series of 1950;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) provides that every local government unit shall exercise powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare;

Continuation...page 2 of City Ordinance No. 22-34 (General):

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "HUMAN RIGHTS AWARENESS WEEK IN THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS ORDINANCE".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY - It is the policy of the City Government of General Trias to:

a. help promote understanding of how the Human Rights empowers all and encourage further reflection on the ways that people can stand up for rights everyday,

b. promote interdependence in all areas of cooperation by identifying city's common strengths and opportunities which will help reduce poverty and improve the quality of life for people whilst developing a knowledge-based society within the City and enhancing community and people empowerment, and

c. enable the City to be capable of interacting with the rest of the province on a more equal footing and contributing more positively towards mutual peace and prosperity.

SECTION 3. CELEBRATION – During this week, citizens are encouraged to be informed of their rights, do their best to secure them, and fight for the rights of fellow Filipinos through different activities and at the same time secure the services and functions offered by the local government unit and private institutions regarding human rights.

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY – The Local Chief Executive shall, in coordination with concerned offices shall formulate the rules and regulations necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION – The funding for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be included in the Annual Budget.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and posting in three (3) conspicuous places in the City.
