ADOPTING SECTION 6, SECTION 7.1 AND SECTION 8 OF THE PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 338-2021 ALSO KNOWN AS "BABAY ASF ORDINANCE OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE", THEREBY INSTITUTIONALIZING THE AFRICAN SWINE FEVER (ASF) BIOSECURITY OFFICERS IN THE CITY, CREATING THE CITY ASF TASK FORCE, & ADOPTING BABAY ASF PROGRAM IN SUPPORT TO THE DECLARATION OF THE CITY AS ASF FREE.

WHEREAS, African Swine Fever (ASF) is a severe viral disease affecting all breeds of domestic and wild pigs, and has already caused grave production and economic losses in the country;

WHEREAS, the prevention and control of African Swine Fever (ASF) is one of the major concerns of the City Government of General Trias;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan ordained Provincial Ordinance No. 338-2021 also known as the "BABAY ASF ORDINANCE OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE" to comply with the Department of Agriculture Administrative Order;

WHEREAS, in support to the different African Swine Fever (ASF) programs in the City, salient provision of Provincial Ordinance No. 338-2021 shall be adopted by the Sanggunian;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the abovementioned Provincial Ordinance states that in maximizing the effort in animal disease monitoring and response to disease outbreaks including other veterinary related concerns at the grassroot level, a Biosecurity Officers shall be organized in the City and corresponding funds shall be allotted for the creation and institutionalization of the said organization;

WHEREAS, Section 7.1 of the said Provincial Ordinance also provides the enactment of local ordinance on the creation of City ASF Task Force to ensure success of the ASF programs in the City;

Continuation...page 2 of City Ordinance No. 22-37 (Special):

WHEREAS, Section 8 of the same Provincial Ordinance states that declaration of ASF Free Status of previously infected barangay areas in the City must be declared by the Provincial ASF Task Force prior to application to be declared ASF Free on the national level;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Felix A. Grepo duly seconded by SP Member Richard R. Parin,

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known as the “BABAY ASF ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS”.

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES

- a. To strengthen and institutionalize LGU engagement for ASF prevention and control,
- b. To establish an effective ASF monitoring, surveillance and reporting system,
- c. To strengthen biosecurity measures at the farm level and border control,
- d. To intensify awareness campaign and other capacity building activities,
- e. To assist in the recovery, rehabilitation, and repopulation of previously affected areas, and
- f. To generate and mobilize resources for an effective implementation of the program.

SECTION 3. INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF ASF BIOSECURITY OFFICERS – Biosecurity Officers shall be organized in the City in line with Republic Act No. 9418 or the “Volunteer Act of 2007”. Registration, deputization, duties and responsibilities of Biosecurity Officers shall be included.

SECTION 4. CREATION OF CITY ASF TASK FORCE – There shall be created City ASF Task Force and its functions to oversee the implementation of the provisions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 5. CITY ORDINANCE – Programs on Bantay ASF sa Barangay “BABay ASF” shall be adopted through City Ordinance.

SECTION 6. DECLARATION OF ASF FREE STATUS – The City must comply with the requirements enshrined in the Department of Agriculture Administrative Order No. 6, Series of 2021 to be declared free from ASF.

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION – The City Government shall appropriate funds for the implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS – For this Ordinance, the ASF Task Force and other offices or personnel as may be deputized by the Local Chief Executive shall be required to formulate an implementing rules and regulations taking into consideration all issuances of the Department of Agriculture on ASF



particularly Department of Agriculture Administrative Order Nos. 06 and 07, Series of 2021.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE - All orders, memoranda, rules and regulations, or any part of parts hereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby revoked or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason a provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, all other provisions hereof not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


