RESOLUTION NO. 67-2001

WHEREAS, the provision of Local Government Code of 1991,
Section 447, Paragraph 4(VII) states that the Sangguniang Bayan
shall regulate the operation and maintenance of entertainment or
amusement facilities to protect the social and moral welfare of
the community;

WHEREAS, elementary pupils and secondary students are
proned to gambling through playing computerized games which can
be played in any business establishment engaged in computerized
or electronic games, and the like;

WHEREAS, a lot of business establishments engaged in
computerized or electronic games and any licensed cockpit arena
do not apply any control measures to prevent pupils and students
to enter such establishment during class hours;

WHEREAS, the school administrators, religious leaders and
non-government organization leaders petitioned to Sangguniang
Bayan an ordinance that will solve the alarming problems that can
retard the maximum intellectual and moral development of the
school clientele;


WHEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Carmelito B. Nocon duly
seconded by SB Member Felix A. Grepo, this Body

RESOLVE, as it is hereby resolved, to enact an ordinance
penalizing owner or operator of business establishments allowing
pupils and students to enter, gamble and play computerized or
electronic games, and other form of gambling thereat during
school days to be designated as Municipal Ordinance No. 04-2001,
to read as follows:

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04-2001

AN ORDINANCE PENALIZING OWNER OR OPERATOR OF BUSINESS
ESTABLISHMENTS ENGAGED IN COMPUTERIZED OR ELECTRONIC GAMES,
KARAOKE AND VIDEO SINGING MACHINES, ANY AUTHORIZED PAGCOR
GAMBLING PLACES AND ANY LICENSED COCKPIT ARENA ALLOWING PUPILS

AND STUDENTS TO ENTER, GAMBLE AND PLAY THEREAT DURING SCHOOL DAYS.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of General Trias, Cavite, that:

SECTION 1 - Regular Acts.

- a. No business establishment, PAGCOR gaming places nor licensed cockpit arena shall allow pupils and students to enter, gamble and play computerized games of play station, counter-strike and the like, karaoke and video singing machines and the like during school days.
- b. No pupils nor students shall be allowed to enter, gamble and play computerized games of play stations, counter-strike and the like, karaoke and video singing machines and the like, and any authorized PAGCOR gambling places and any licensed cockpit arena during school days.

SECTION 2 - Penalty.

- a. Any owner or operator business establishments caught violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of P2,500 and imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
- b. Pupils and students caught violating any provisions of this ordinance during daytime shall be recorded of their names in the PNP log book for evidentiary purposes and be released subsequently to respective school principal for the imposition of the schools own code of disciplinary actions.
- c. Pupils and students caught violating any provisions of this ordinance during night time shall be recorded of their names in the PNP log book and subsequently be released to their parents or guardians and PNP shall report within 24 hours the subject pupils and students to their respective school principal for appropriate action as above-stated.

SECTION 3 - Exemptions.

When pupils and students entrance in the above-stated establishments is part of their school assignment and research with permit from the school officials concerned.
