RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to enact an
ordinance adopting the act on salt iodization nationwide
pursuant to Sec. 2 of the Republic Act 8192 and Provincial
Ordinance NO. 98-002 requiring salt traders,
producers/suppliers to sell only iodized salt and all food
establishments such as restaurant, canteens, hotels,
hospitals and other food outlet as well as food
manufacturers to use iodized salt, to be designated as
Municipal Ordinance No. 08-2000, to read as follows:

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 08-2000

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE ACT ON SALT IODIZATION NATIONWIDE
PURSUANT TO SECTION 2 OF THE REPUBLIC ACT 8172 AND
PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 98-002. THIS WILL REQUIRED SALT
TRADERS, PRODUCERS/SUPPLIERS TO SELL ONLY IODIZED SALT AND
ALL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS SUCH AS RESTAURANT, CANTEENS,
HOTELS, HOSPITAL AND OTHER FOOD OUTLET AS WELL AS FOOD
MANUFACTURERS TO USE IODIZED SALT.

Trias, Cavite, that:

SECTION I. - This ordinance shall be known as INTENSIFICATION OF THE USE OF IODIZED SALT in the municipality of General Trias, Cavite.

SECTION II. - These rules and regulations shall be construed in manner that can achieve the objectives of R.A. 8172, namely:

- a. To contribute to the elimination of micronutrient malnutrition particularly IODINE DEFICIENCY DISORDER (IDD).
- b. For the local government agency to undertake their roles in carrying out the provisions of this ordinance.
- c. To ensure the sustainability of the salt iodization program.

SECTION III. - Applicability of this ordinance shall be within the entire jurisdiction of the municipality of General Trias, and shall be implemented by the Office of the Local Executive thru the Municipal Health Officer or its duly authorized representative.

SECTION IV. - LEGAL BASIS: The basis of the ordinance is the exercise of the police power of the municipality to ensure the health general welfare of the public.

SECTION V. - All salt producers and traders/suppliers and retailers to sell only iodized salt for human and animal consumption.

SECTION VI. - All commercial food establishments such as restaurants, canteens, hotel, hospitals, caterers, all other food outlets as well as food manufacturers to use only iodized salt in food processing, food preparation and table service.

SECTION VII. - The Office of the Local Executive thru the Nutrition committee shall act, as the Salt Iodization Program Implementing Committee to be chaired by the Local Health Officer shall:

- a. Formulate guidelines for the effective implementation of this ordinance.
- b. Conduct quarterly monitoring the quality of the iodized salt distributed and sold in the market and that of being used by food establishments.
- c. Develop and implement a promotional plan on the use of iodized salt.

SECTION VIII. - A Certificate of Salt Iodization issued by the local health authority shall be added to the requirements for food related establishments upon applying/renewal of Sanitary Permit.

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SECTION IX. - Any producer/manufacturer, distributor, food outlets, restaurants and stores who violates this ordinance shall be penalized in the amount of not less than One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) but not more that One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00).


In the imposition of the said administrative penalty, the imposible fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) to Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) shall be considered minimum penalty. Thirty-One Thousand Pesos (P31,000.00) to Sixty Thousand Pesos (P60,000.00) as medium penalty, and Sixty-One Thousand Pesos (P61,000.00) to One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) as the maximum penalty: provided that the maximum fine shall be in addition to the revocation of the offenders License to Operate and Sanitary Permit and provides further that in all cases where the subject matter of the offense is a prohibited product, the Municipal Health Officer or his duly authorized representative shall order the recall and/or withdrawal of the product from the market or establishment.


SECTION X. - EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




