AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 01, S. 2009 BY EXPANDING ITS COVERAGE, UPGRADING STANDARDS, PROVIDING ACCESS TO RECORDINGS AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION.

WHEREAS, the scope of coverage, upgrading the standards, access to recording and imposing penalties in violation of Municipal Ordinance No. 01, S. 2009 also known as Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) Ordinance are necessary;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Florencio D. Ayos duly seconded by SB Member Kerby J. Salazar, SB Member Christopher N. Custodio, SB Member Lamberto M. Carampot, SB Member Walter C. Martinez, SB Member Richard R. Parin, SB Member Mario C. Amante, SB Member Jonas Glyn P. Labuguen, SB Member Gary A. Grepo and SB Member Jayvie Arisa I. Simpan,

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in regular session assembled:

Section 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 01, S. 2009 BY EXPANDING ITS COVERAGE, UPGRADING STANDARDS, PROVIDING ACCESS TO RECORDINGS AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION.

Section 2. Section 1 of the Municipal Ordinance No. 01, S. 2009 is hereby amended, to read as follows:

COVERED ESTABLISHMENT - This Ordinance shall cover banks, malls, gasoline stations, supermarkets, pawnshops, money-changers, convenience stores, private schools, fast food restaurants/quick service restaurants (QSRs) with an area of above 50 square meters, car dealership and other business establishment with a daily average gross sales of Php50,000.00.

Section 3. Section 2 of the Municipal Ordinance No. 01, S. 2009 is hereby amended, to be read as follows:

MINIMUM TECHNOLOGICAL STANDARDS - The CCTV or video surveillance system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity, the physical features of individuals and areas within the premises, and must be able to record such images on digital, optical or magnetic media.

For this purpose, the CCTV or video surveillance shall meet the following minimum specifications:

- One dedicated channel per camera in operation
- b. 640x480 pixel resolution recording level
- c. Recording speeds of fifteen frames per second (15 fps)
- d. Sufficient memory to retain data for at least thirty (30) days, with redundancy or back-up to preserve the data
- Time-stamping feature e.
- With retrieval and viewing functions while in operation
- g. Provided with independent uninterruptible power supply (UPS) system
- h. Data or captured images/footage can be stored on digital, optical or magnetic media for evidentiary purpose.

Section 4. ACCESS TO RECORDINGS - If a crime has occurred, or the operator, employee or owner of the establishment has reason to believe a crime has occurred and has been recorded by the surveillance system, the operator, employee or owner of the establishment shall immediately contact the police, and shall provide access to the pertinent recordings to the police and other investigators. The captured video footage or images maybe used at any time to satisfy the written order or subpoena of any court or body with competent jurisdiction.

Section 5. IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES

1st Offense

Reprimand

2nd Offense

Php 2,000.00 (after a month)

3rd Offense

Revocation of business permit (after a month)

Section 6. SEPARABLITY CLAUSE - If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 7. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provision thereof are hereby repealed.

Section 8. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect on 01 January 2014, following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation or posting of its copies in conspicuous places in the Municipality.
